



Long Island Farm to Preschool is Hiring!

Long Island Farm to Preschool is a grant-funded program that aims to increase access to fresh fruits and vegetables in underserved areas of Long Island by providing farm stands, cooking demonstrations, gardening, and education for children, parents, staff and the surrounding communities of child care centers in both Nassau and Suffolk counties.

Summary: Assist in running seasonal farm stand program at four Long Island child care centers. Five **SEASONAL** positions available:

- One **PAID ASSISTANT** who is available to work 10-18 hours weekly at various market sites from June through September.
- Four **VOLUNTEERS** who are available for at least 7 consecutive weeks and at least 5 hours per week at various market sites from June through September.

Primary responsibilities for all positions include the following. Other duties may be assigned as needed.

- Assist in set up and breakdown of all market equipment including tents, tables, and cooking equipment
- Assist farmers with setup and breakdown of their displays
- Interact with and assist customers of farm stand with purchases and payments
- Assist in distributing educational materials and giveaway items to parents
- Assist with cooking demos as needed
- Assist with maintaining sales records
- Assist in creating educational materials and displays for childcare centers
- Support centers in gardening projects
- Assist in nutrition education activities with children at centers around farmers market; tastings, lessons, talking to a farmer, etc.
- Make weekly produce delivery to other sites in the area

Candidate should be able to:

- Lift at least 50 pounds
- Work outdoors in inclement weather
- Provide own transportation to market sites
- Be comfortable working with preschool aged children
- Bilingual preferred
